Admissions Requirements

Domestic and International Applicants

Candidates must provide the following items to be considered for admission to the MAPM program:

- An official transcript from each postsecondary institution attended, whether or not a degree was earned. All official transcripts must be certified by a Justice of the Peace (JP)*
- Proof of a completed degree, if proof of completion is not noted in the certified transcript
- Proof of English proficiency (if required)
- Completed and signed University of Adelaide application**

* A Justice of the Peace (JP) is someone of good stature in the community who is authorised to certify copies of original documents.
